#### WP4 overview

#### Objectives:

- Deploy, operate and evaluate a generic catalogue of scientific data across the participating facilities
- The metadata catalogue service will build on the policy and data standards developed in the PaNdata Support Action
- The creation of a cross-facility data catalogue
- Demonstrate the service in particular for the user communities through Virtual Laboratories



### Data catalogues

- This WP will not develop a new metadata catalogue but instead use one of the existing implementations.
- Inside the PaNdata community the ICAT is already being deployed at 4 (at proposal time) of the partner facilities making it the obvious choice

• ICAT 3.\* → ICAT 4.0 (now) → ICAT 4.1 (June?)

(4.1: the first release with input from PaNdata.)



# Collaboration agreement (draft) 1

#### During 2012, PaNdata WP4 will:

- Test release materials for ICAT and provide feedback;
- Provide a set of requirements for ICAT and maintain the list indicating their priority;
- Provide strategic advice to the ICAT collaboration on the requirements of the PaNdata deployments;
- Provide a named contact at each of the PaNdata partners for ICAT matters; the person should attend the ICAT collaboration meetings, at least once per quarter;
- Provide technical contributions from each the larger partners.
- Lead WP7 of ICAT, Specific facility integration.



# Collaboration agreement (draft) 2

#### During 2012, ICAT collaboration will:

- Provide materials in a reasonable state for testing;
- React in a reasonable time to requests for assistance;
- Try to meet the requirements of PaNdata in a timely manner;
- Attend meetings of WP4 when invited.



#### Current activities



- Installation / testing of ICAT 4.0.
  - Diamond has been successfully using ICAT for almost 2 years now (over 100 M files which is approx 297 Tb)
  - <u>Contacts</u>: Andy and Dominique for ESRF (ESRF will recruit two engineers for the ICAT by April); Tom for ISIS, Idrissou for Soleil, Jean-François for ILL, Joachim and Daniel for ALBA, George and Milan for Elettra,...

- Analysis of the alternative data catalogues (Survey)
  - Feature comparison
  - Possible interaction










# Goal: 50% uptake...
