What is it?

It is a java client application jar which can:

- write an xml file which describes the content of an ICAT;
- read the xml file and load the contents into an ICAT.

When is this useful?

- need to copy data from an ICAT and load it into another ICAT;
- need to copy data from an ICAT and load it into some other catalogue.

Is anyone using it?

- ESRF to import tomography data from an xml file from another application;
- RAL is using it to investigate data migration to a Tardis catalog;
- RAL is using it to investigate data migration to a CKAN catalog.
